PRESENTAZIONE DELLA MOSTRA

20 Marzo 2021

Durante questa interminabile pandemia di Covid-19, gli artisti hanno utilizzato sempre di più le gallerie virtuali in 3D per continuare a mostrare al pubblico le loro opere. Non più spazi reali, ma spazi virtuali più limitati rispetto a quelli offerti da una galleria tradizionale, non tanto per il numero teorico di opere che si possono esporre, ma soprattutto per i tempi di caricamento della galleria stessa. Una galleria virtuale in 3D troppo pesante (in megabyte) può infatti determinare, soprattutto con hardware meno recenti, rallentamenti in fase di avvio. Si consigliano in genere non più di venti opere per galleria, ma noi abbiamo abbondantemente superato questa soglia e quindi rinunceremo agli effetti speciali (che in verità non avremo comunque inserito). Detto questo, va rilevato che le gallerie virtuali in 3D sono rivolte ad un pubblico molto più ampio di quanto gli spazi reali consentano, anche se allestiti in location prestigiose. Per contro, il visitatore può solo vedere la foto dell'opera e non l'opera reale come nelle gallerie tradizionali.

Il visitatore di questa mostra, sarà comunque gratificato dal fatto che troverà un'ampia varietà di generi artistici: dalle bambole di tessuto alla ceramica artistica; dalla fotografia in bianco e nero al disegno a china; dalla pittura ad olio, all'acrilico e all'acquerello; dai generi pittorici più tradizionali alle copie d'autore.

Caroggi è onorata di esporre insieme agli Artisti che hanno aderito al progetto "Free collective exhibition in 3D", nonostante i tempi ristretti, e li ringrazia per la partecipazione. La copertina e il poster della mostra sono stati dedicati, rispettivamente, a Sabrina Lettieri, per le bambole in tessuto, e a Nilde, per la ceramica artistica.

La mostra pubblicata oggi sarà visibile online fino al 25 Aprile 2021. Buona visione a tutti dallo staff Arte Caroggi.

EXHIBITION PRESENTATION

20 March 2021

During this interminable Covid-19 pandemic, artists have increasingly used the virtual galleries in 3D to continue showing their works to the public. No longer real-spaces, but more limited virtual spaces than those offered by a traditional gallery, not so much for the theoretical number of works that can be exhibited, but above all for the loading times of the gallery itself. A 3D virtual gallery that is too heavy (in megabytes) can cause slowdowns during startup, especially with older hardware. It is, generally, recommended no more than twenty works per gallery but, we have abundantly exceeded this threshold and, therefore, we will give up the special effects (which, in truth, we will not have included anyway). Having said that, it should be noted that 3D virtual galleries are addressed to a much wider audience than real-spaces allow, even if set up in prestigious locations. On the other hand, the visitor can only see the work in a photo and not the real-work as in traditional galleries.

The visitor of this exhibition, in any case, will be gratified by the fact that he will find a wide variety of artistic genres: from fabric dolls to artistic ceramics; from black and white photography to Indian ink drawing; from oil painting to acrylic and watercolor; from the more traditional pictorial genres to author copies.

Caroggi is honored to exhibit together with the Artists who have joined the "Free collective exhibition in 3D" project, despite the tight deadline, and thanks to them for participating. The cover and the poster of the exhibition were dedicated, respectively, to Sabrina Lettieri, for the fabric dolls, and Nilde, for artistic ceramics.

The exhibition published today will be visible online until April 25, 2021. Good vision to all by the Arte Caroggi staff.

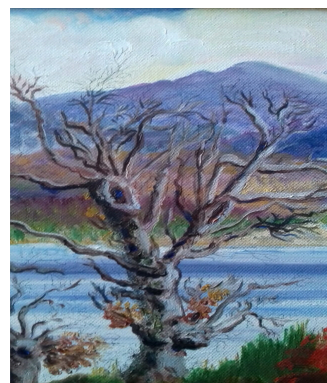

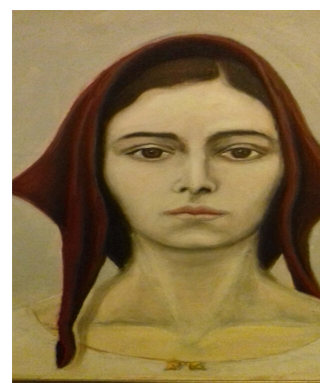

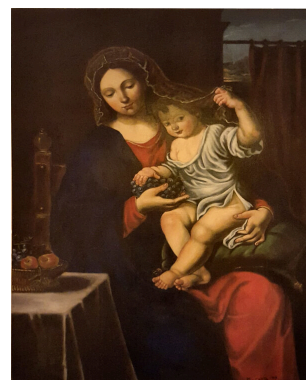

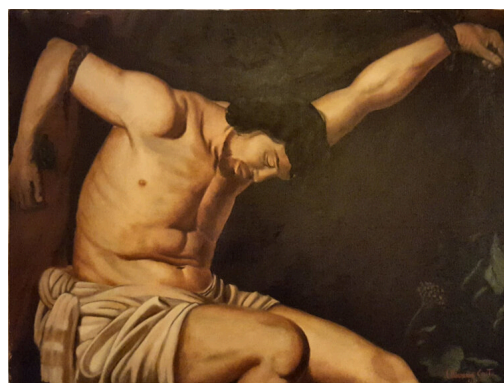

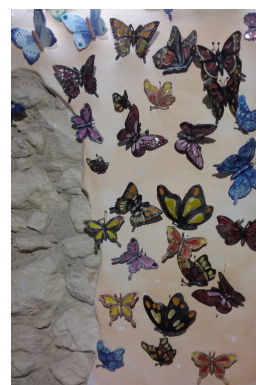

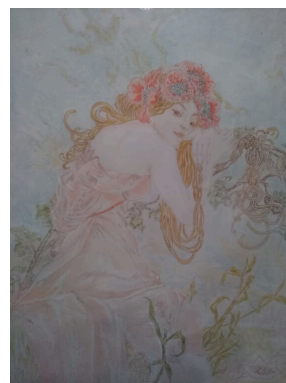

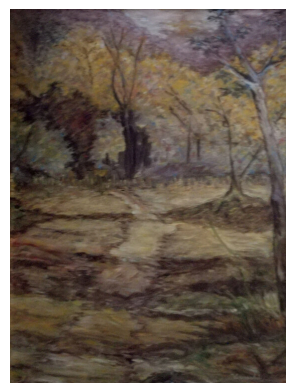

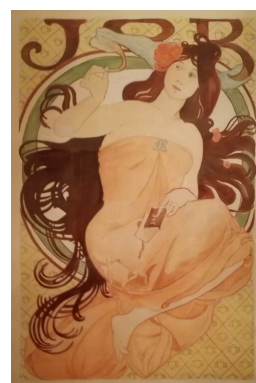

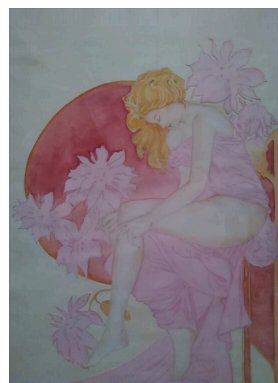

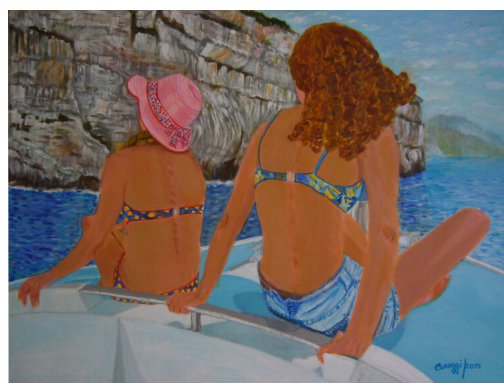
